### City of Gjakova

Gjakova (Albanian: Gjakovë) is a city and municipality located in the Gjakova District on western Kosovo. According to the 2011 registration, the city of Gjakova has 40,827 inhabitants, while the municipality has 94,556 inhabitants. Geographically, it is located in the south-western part of Kosovo, about halfway between the cities of Peja and Prizren. It is approximately 100 km (62 mi) inland from the Adriatic Sea. The city is situated some 208 kilometers north-east of Tirana, 145 kilometers north-west of Skopje, 80 kilometers west of the capital Pristina and 263 kilometers east of Podgorica. Masterpieces of nature, which have not been spared at all with the beauties that have been given to this area are Rugova Valley 45 km away and Valbona Valley 60 km away.

Visitors arriving by air can fly to the Prishtina International Airport "Adem Jashari" which is 70 km from the city center and from the Venue. A complete flight schedule for Prishtina International Airport is available on the airport's website. Also, you can fly from Mother Teresa Airport in Tirana and Skopje Airport, which are approximately 200 km from Gjakova,

## **Taxis**

Taxis are readily available at the all airports. Airport Taxis are the authorized airport taxis; however, many other taxis also wait to pick up passengers. Visitors are advised to accept rides from only airport taxis. The official prices from Prishtina Airport are 60 - 70 euro.

## **Busses**

There is a line of public transport of busses connecting Prishtina International Airport with Prishtina City and Gjakova.
